Types of tickets and prices

1 journey ticket

The best way for a spontaneous journey by public transport

- •Valid on all public transport services in the core zone Vienna
- •Valid for one trip in one direction
- •The ticket holder can change lines (as often as they like)
- •The journey may not be interrupted

price: €2.20

4 journey ticket

- 4 journeys using the public transport services
- •Each strip is valid for one single trip
- •Several persons can use the ticket at the same time
- •One strip must be validated per person
- •Valid for one trip in one direction
- •The ticket holder can change lines
- •The journey may not be interrupted

price: €8.80

24-h Vienna ticket

Ideal for visitors who want to see as much of the city as possible in the shortest possible time.

- •Valid for 24 hours from the stated date and time
- •Valid on all public transport services in Vienna
- •Ticket purchase possible a maximum of 60 days before validity date
- •This ticket is not transferable

price: €7.60



48 hours Vienna ticket

Ideal for visitors who want to see as much of the city as possible in the shortest possible time.

- •Valid for 48 hours from the stated date and time
- •Valid on all public transport services in Vienna
- •Ticket purchase possible a maximum of 60 days before validity date
- •This ticket is not transferable

price: €13.30

72 hours Vienna ticket

Ideal for visitors who want to explore the city for 72 hours.

- •Valid for 72 hours from the stated date and time
- Valid for all public transport services in Vienna
- •Ticket purchase possible a maximum of 60 days before validity date
- •This ticket is not transferable

price: €16.50

Vienna weekly ticket

One week of unlimited travel throughout the city

- •Valid from midnight on Monday until 9.00 am on the following Monday
- •Valid on all public transport services in Vienna
- •Ticket purchase possible a maximum of 60 days before validity date
- •This ticket is not transferable

price: €16.20

TIPS

- For the Congress days the cheapest option would be to buy a weekly ticket. Keep in mind that the weekly ticket is valid from midnight on Monday until 9.00 am on the following Monday.
- If you are arriving before Monday, you will need to buy additional tickets. You can choose to buy different types of tickets depending on your plans:
 - o If you are arriving on Saturday or Sunday and you only need to get from the airport to the hotel/Pre-conferences venues, the best option for you would be to use 1 journey or 4 journey tickets
 - o If you are arriving on Saturday or Sunday and apart from the pre-conferences you have planned some additional touristic programme, you should probably buy a 24-hour ticket/48-hour ticket/72-hour ticket, depending on your time and plans.
